

Below these is a section titled "Looking for something else?" with four more options:

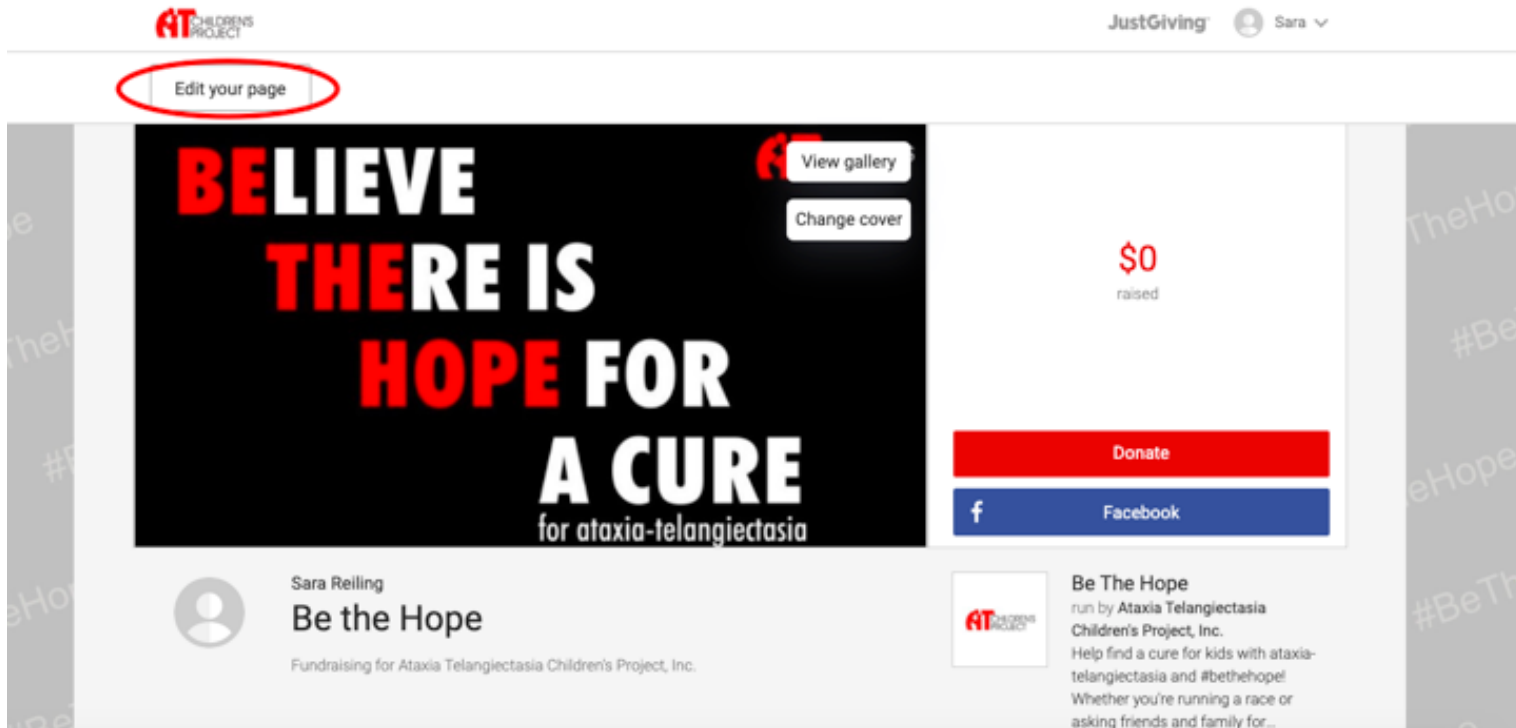
- Taking part in an event**: From a marathon, triathlon or charity bike ride to a sponsored walk or trek. Raise money for any official event.

- Doing your own thing**: Shave your head, give up chocolate, do something unique...

It will ask you about your event type and name. *You have to input something even if there is no event.* The type can be "an appeal for a charity" and you can name it the same as your page title – ex: Cathy's Crusade Against A-T.

This section is also where you'll also be able to customize your fundraising page's URL.



On the next window, select 'Edit your page' to customize your page.
